

RESOLUTION 2020-21/059


BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Bryan County, Oklahoma on this 1st day of June, 2020, that per Bryan County Treasurer's written recommendation, the tax resale referenced in 68 O.S. Section 3125 WILL NOT be held the 2nd Monday in June of 2020.

Due to the declaration of the State of Emergency regarding COVID-19 pandemic 81 O.S. Section 6101 et.esq. issued by J. KEVIN STITT, Governor of the State of Oklahoma, the referenced duties to be performed in 68 O.S. Section 3148 has been amended to include the language IN THE EVENT THE GOVERNOR DELCARES A CATASTROPHIC HEALTH EMERGENCY AS PROVIDED IN 81 O.S. SECTION 6101 et.esq.; THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, UPON THE WRITTEN REQUEST OF THE COUNTY TREASURER, SHALL POSTPONE DELINQUENT TAX SALES AND RELATED DELINQUENT TAX NOTICES AND PUBLICATIONS. THE COUNTY TREASURER SHALL DESIGNATE THE PERIOD OF POSTPONEMENT UP TO BUT NOT MORE THAN ONE YEAR, UPON POSTPONEMENT UPT TO BUT NOT MORE THAT ONE YEAR. UPON POSTPONEMENT ACTION BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, THE COUNTY TREASURER SHALL ADVERTISE THE DETAILS OF THE POSTPONEMENT IN THE SAME MANNER AS OTHER DELIQUENT TAX LEGAL PUBLICATION ONCE PER WEEK FOR FOUR CONSECUTIVE WEEKS.

Please be advised, as Treasurer of Bryan County, Oklahoma, I, Prudy Sullivan-Holt, am requesting the postponement of the 2020 June Resale as specified in the emergency amendment to the legislature due to the adverse effects of COVID-19 Health Pandemic. I will add this year's parcels to the next scheduled June Resale in June 2021.

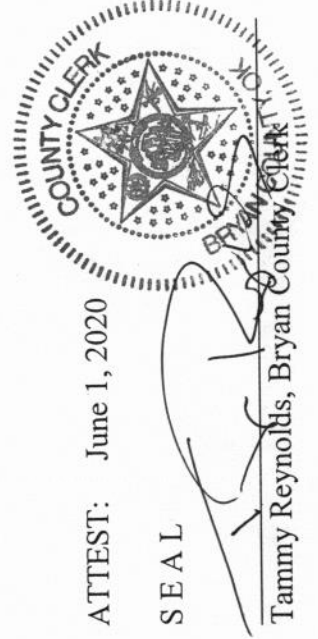
